



## 2020 Wabash & Erie Canal Event details

- **Canal Days July 4** (held outside in Pioneer Village). Crafted arts, food and gift items should be historical in nature where possible, related to the pioneer/canal theme. Costume or farm themed clothing is preferred, but not required for volunteers, vendors and exhibitors.
- **Christmas at the Canal Dec 5** (held inside Interpretive Center) Crafted arts, food and gift items. Food items, not to compete with the lunch items sold at the Christmas Kitchen including cookies and apple dumplings.
- Vendors are responsible for their own IN Retail Sales Tax and any other related taxes or permit(s), if applicable.
- Tables, chairs, tents, props, provided by the vendor.
- Check in with Event Coordinator when you arrive for details & location.
- Set up time 8-9:30AM before event begins. Complete your set up and vehicles moved to parking site by 9:30AM prior to official opening time. Pickup and vehicles allowed in once program is officially closed after 4:15PM.
- Your space must be left clean as when arrived.
- Events held rain or shine, no refunds.
- Applications due for: **Canal Days** by June 1 and **Christmas at the Canal** by Nov 1. Late fee \$10 additional per space after due date.
- Vendors @\$35/space plus 10% of gross sales exceeding \$350 for the day. Spaces are approx. 10x10', maximum 2 spaces allowed per vendor.
